around June.



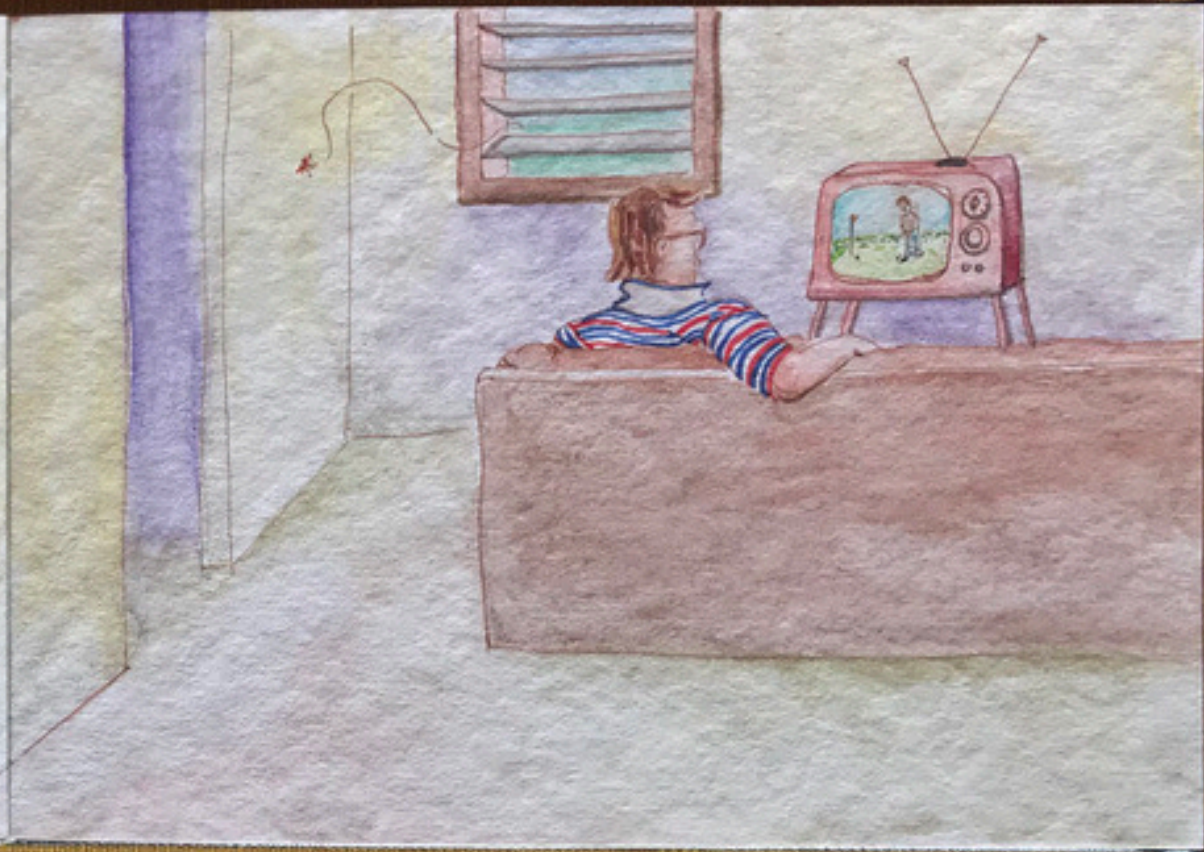
June bugs are very

said Grandad.

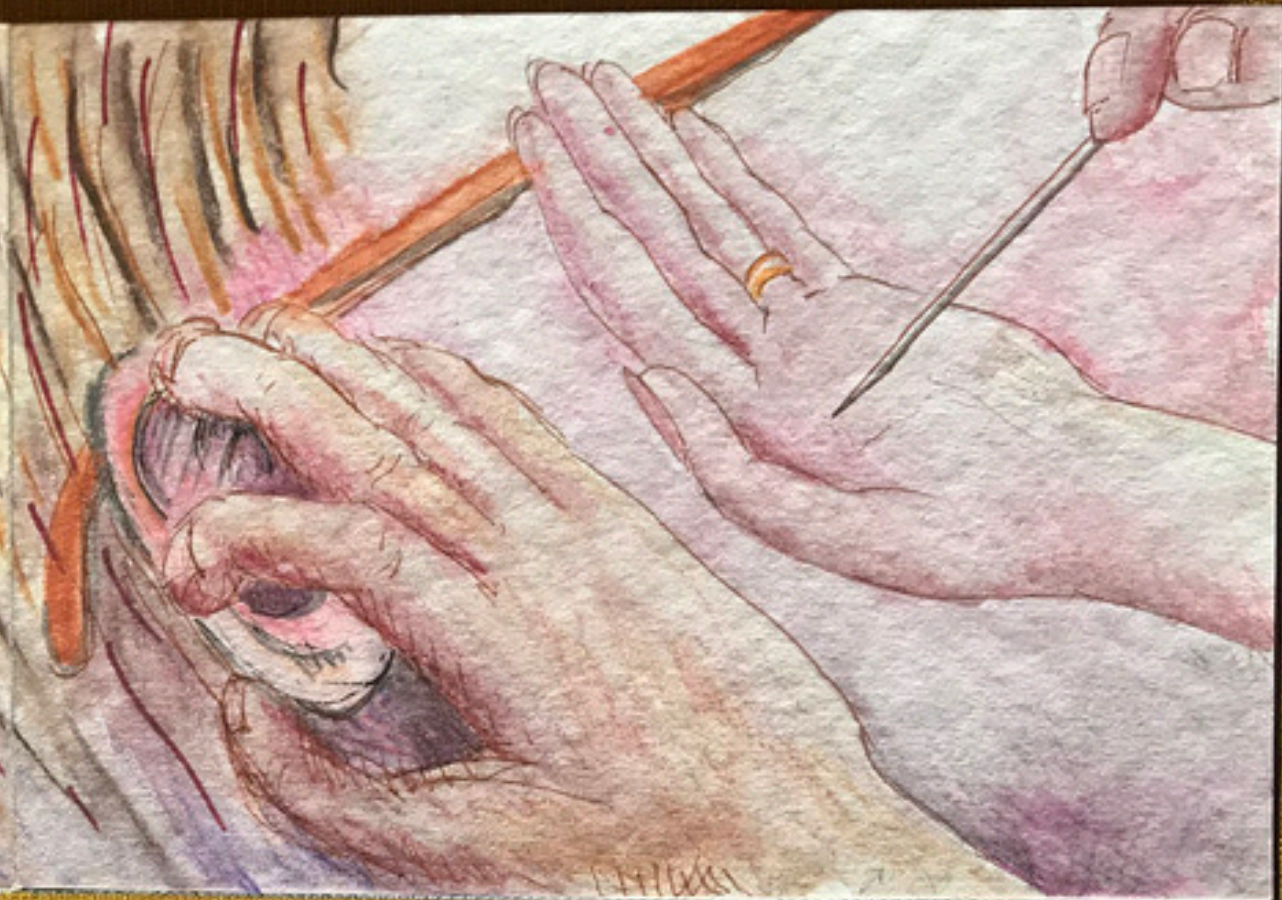


Great Grandad BOB

OUT with a metal skewer.

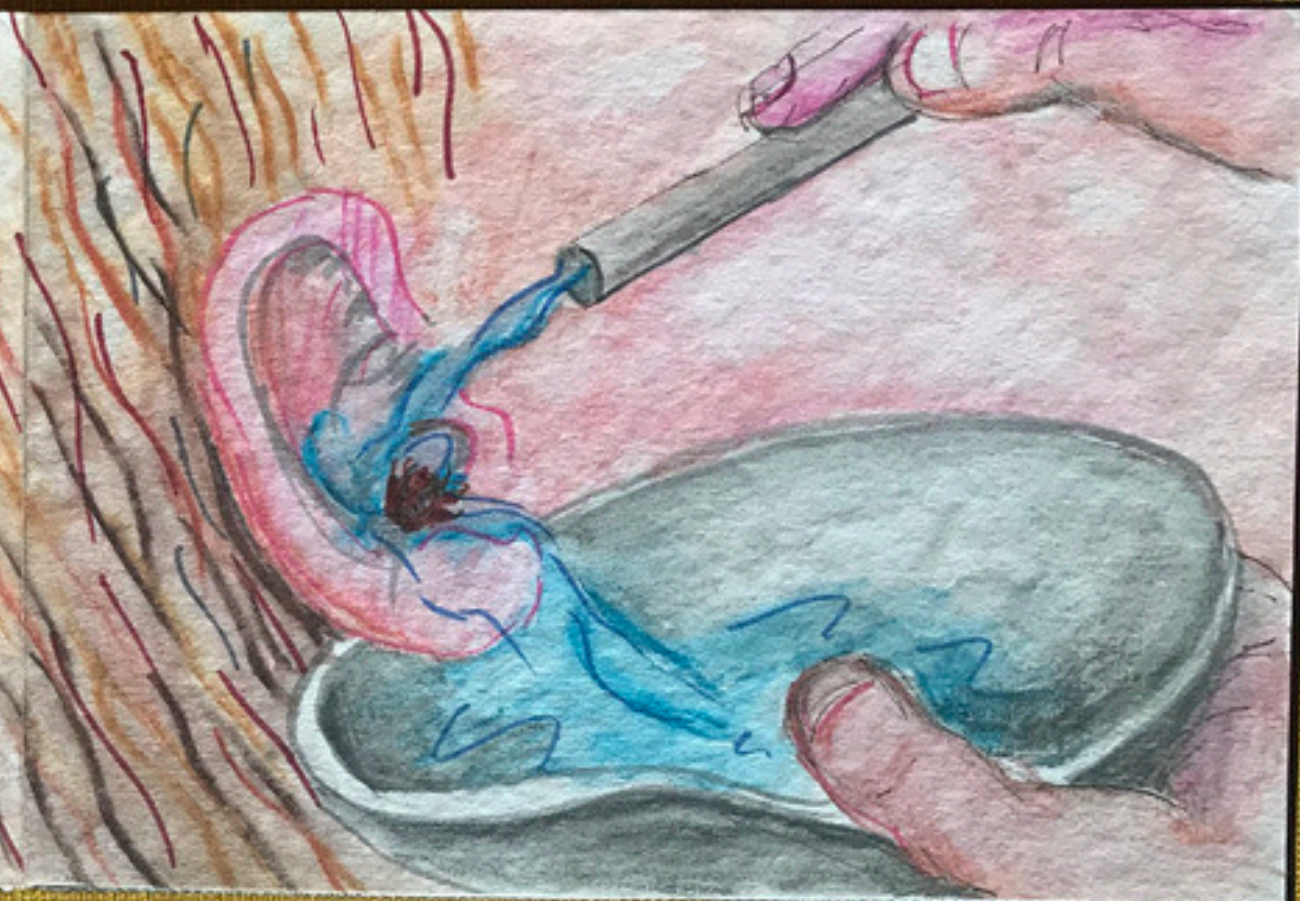
NO!

Stick to Banking Bob.....

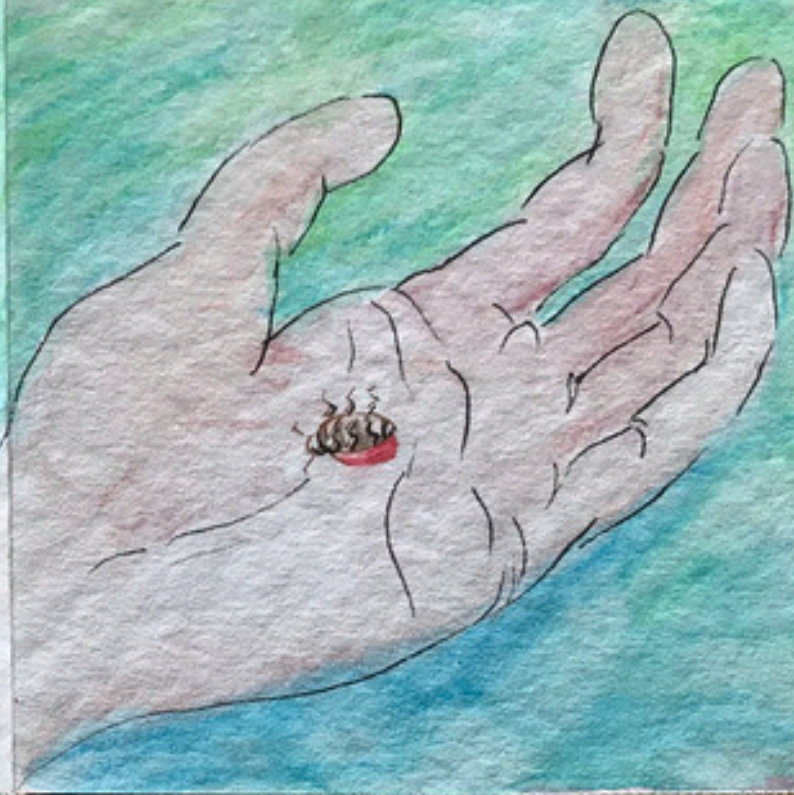
They shoe'd Bob away.
